PASTOR SHERYL BRADY'S NEW BOOK ON EMPOWERING WOMEN IS THEME FOR 20TH ANNIVERSARY OF BISHOP T.D. JAKES' ANNUAL WOMEN'S CONFERENCE

The theme from this year's conference is taken from Pastor Sheryl Brady's new book, *You Have It In You!:* Empowered to do the Impossible (Howard Books / 9781451674101), set for release on Oct. 2. Like the annual Woman, Thou Art Loosed! conference, Pastor Brady's book encourages readers to embrace their gifts, muster up courage, define their purpose and pursue it heartily:

"Believe [in God] for the impossible, the unimaginable, the unobtainable, and the incurable," writes Pastor Brady. "Each time we trust him with another layer of our lives, we discover more of the buried treasure of our true identities," (pg. 183, 12).

Pastor Brady will also host a book signing during the conference.

In addition to Pastor Brady's new book, a special 20th anniversary edition of Bishop T.D.
